The GVF aims to be the go-to resource and has plans to work tirelessly to raise public awareness for Vitiligo, to expand the base of knowledge on its causes and treatment, and to advocate for the recognition of Vitiligo care as medically necessary. Our mission-driven initiatives include:

- **Annual Scientific Symposium:** The annual call for abstracts forms the basis for the half-day conference that convenes the day before the AAD and features, some of the best researchers and clinicians in the world to focus on the scientific advancements in GVF. The forum includes dermatologists, research fellows, residents, medical students and individuals with vitiligo.
- **World Vitiligo Day—USA:** This patient-led initiative, backed by the GVF, unites Vitiligo patients worldwide to learn about research updates and how to cope with Vitiligo, providing support and knowledge to the largest gathering of Vitiligo patients in the United States.
- **Camp Victory:** Camp Victory is a new and exciting initiative that focuses on improving the quality of life for children with Vitiligo and their families and seeks to promote Victory Over Vitiligo through education, counseling, and fostering valuable interactions among children and families facing the same condition.
- **Vitiligo Physician Education Summit:** A cutting-edge medical educational meeting designed to equip physicians with the essential knowledge and tools needed for accurate identification, diagnosis, and effective treatment of Vitiligo.
- **Patient Resources:** GVF is dedicated to education and is actively creating online resources for patients and physicians, collaborating with social media experts to ensure widespread dissemination of these materials.
- **Grants:** GVF provides grants to patient support groups to assist with outreach, education, and connection to resources for people with Vitiligo.
- **Fellowships:** GVF provides research support in the form of \$75,000 fellowships to physicians interested in careers dedicated to Vitiligo research, education, and clinical care.
- **Research:** Through the hard work and altruistic giving of physicians and researchers, GVF licenses clinical trial protocols, patient-related assessments and outcome measures to research institutions and pharmaceutical companies.
